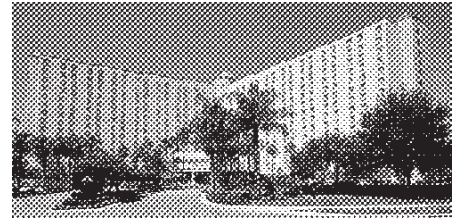

Rosen Plaza Hotel Discounted Hotel Rooms

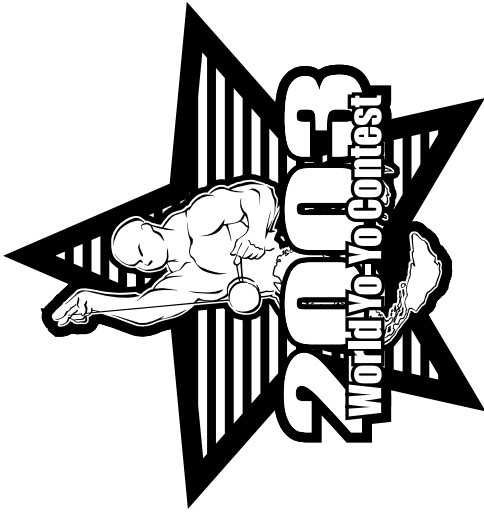


The 2002 World Yo-Yo Contest will be held in the convention center of the Rosen Plaza Hotel on International Drive in Orlando Florida. The hall will be open 24 hours a day, starting 6pm Thursday evening and ending on Sunday at 5pm. We encourage staying at this hotel to enjoy the event to its fullest, as it's not going to stop all weekend! There are 24-hour restaurants in this hotel and a variety of recreational activities within walking distance of this hotel. It is also convenient to all major tourist attractions.

Convention rate: \$85.00/night per room (up to 4 occupancy). Reservations can be made by phone at 1-800-627-8258. Just ask for the World Yo-Yo Contest convention rate. On-line reservations can be made from our website.

Notable changes for 2003:

- The doors open Thursday Night at 6pm, and the curtain falls at about 5pm on Sunday.
- No world-level contests will take place on Friday, so if you cannot make it that day, you can still compete.
- The X division has been split into three divisions: 3A (Two handed non-looping), OS (Off String) and CW (Counter Weight or Freehand). Each division will have a compulsory and a freestyle.
- Any contestant can enter any or all world-level categories.
- The trick order for A and AA compulsories may differ from the order on the published trick list. Do not expect to do them in this order!
- Lucky Meisenheimer invites you to his house for a poolside BBQ. Lucky is the author of Lucky's Guide to 20th Century Collectable Yo-Yos, and has one of the world's foremost yo-yo museums in his house (located near the hotel) The museum will be open for viewing. Tickets for this informal dinner are \$25.00 per ticket. Remember to bring your swim trunks and towels as well as your copy of his book for him to sign.
