I look around the hall, and I realize I've been doing this for longer than many of the contestants have been alive.

I think this is why I write these introductions. I like to take as well as give perspective on what I see. As recently as 1993, I was able to take third place in the second highest division at Worlds (yes, GReg can yo-yo, just not as good as you guys can now) and now I can't even do what many people consider basic moves.



It makes me wonder what we will think about the tricks that will be done at Worlds in 2021. It also makes me understand the wide eyed amusement I see from the older players who got us here, like Dale Oliver.

I also see yo-yoing being more appreciated. Hiroyuki Suzuki's Worlds video from 2006 is a youtube viral hit, also on ifilm and a ton of other places. (I don't know how many links to that video I've been sent from folks I know who don't realize I run the World Yo-Yo Contest.) The clip has also made it onto Spike TV.

But I see the new interest in yo-yoing not stopping there. This year we have a film crew which is trying to take our event to the networks. We also have a trailer we hope to show this year of a full scale yo-yo documentary, parts of which were filmed at a past World Yo-Yo Contest. And then we have *Sukaban Deka – Yo-Yo Girl Cop*, a feature length Japanese action film that our own National Master Taka helped in the making of.

All in all the bricks we have been laying have built an amazing foundation for our sport.

I also want to thank the new sponsors for this year: Spingear and HSpin. It's good to see that support for Worlds is growing too.

Thanks again for coming to my party. If you make it to Lucky's BBQ, there will be cake at my party to help celebrate those 20 years.
